Once again we will be purchasing all the needed school supplies for all students next year. We ask that if you can, please pay \$30 per child to cover the costs. To pay please visit the school website https://sid.sd61.bc.ca/ and click the link "School Cash Online Payments" You will be prompted to either sign in or register. It is important to set up your account as this is the method of payment that will be used for all school events from K to the end of grade 12.

Here is the link <u>https://www.schoolcashonline.com/</u>. If you wish, you are welcome to pay for an additional child. This will help to cover the costs for those families who cannot pay.

All funds will be used to pay for students' school supplies. Even if you are not going to be contributing to this school purchase of supplies, **please do not send your child to the school with supplies you have purchased**. One of the main advantages of doing purchasing in this manner is the uniformity of supplies that it creates. Any excess funds at the end of the school year will go to the PAC to be used for their school initiatives.

All school fees will be added on to your child's account and can be paid for online, in cash, or cheque at the school. Unfortunately we cannot accept e-transfers.

No child will go without supplies or activities related to their classroom. If you are having financial difficulty and will need the fees for supplies and other items paid for by the school district, please let me know by email, phone, or in person. I am happy to help and all that you share with me about your situation will be private and confidential.
